ORDER

The complaint in this case was filed on November 23, 2016, along with motions for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction. (Dkt. Nos. 1, 3, & 4.) The affidavit of service indicates that the complaint was not served until December 1, 2016. Dkt. 11. Given the date of service, the answer is not due in this case until December 22, 2016.

Counsel for Plaintiff has today contacted the clerk's office to inquire about the status of the motions. No appearance has as yet been filed by any attorney for Defendant. With this background, the court orders as follows.

1. If counsel for Plaintiff is requesting an immediate ex parte hearing on the motion for temporary restraining order, a motion making this request will be filed on or before December 14, 2016, setting forth compelling reasons for immediate court action.

2. A copy of this order will be conveyed to Defendant by Plaintiff's counsel.

3. Defendant will file its answer or other responsive pleading on or before December 22, 2016.

4. Unless an immediate hearing is granted for good cause, the clerk will schedule a hearing on Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction in early January.
